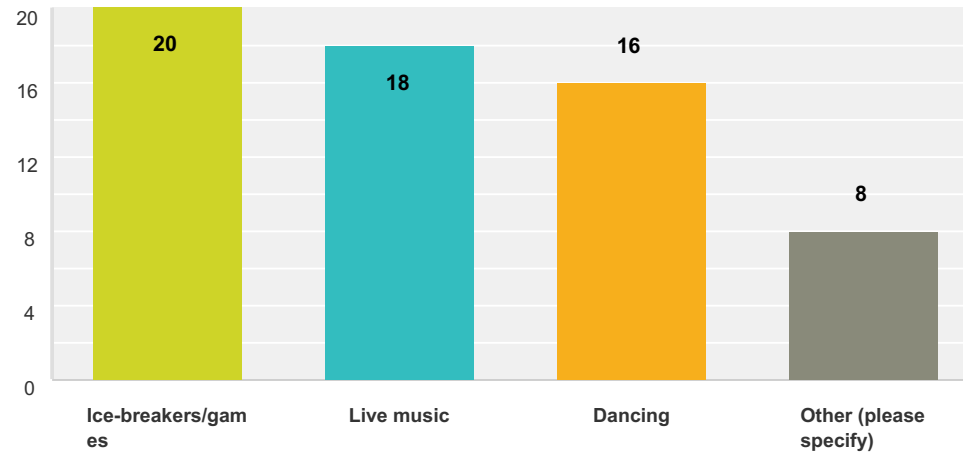

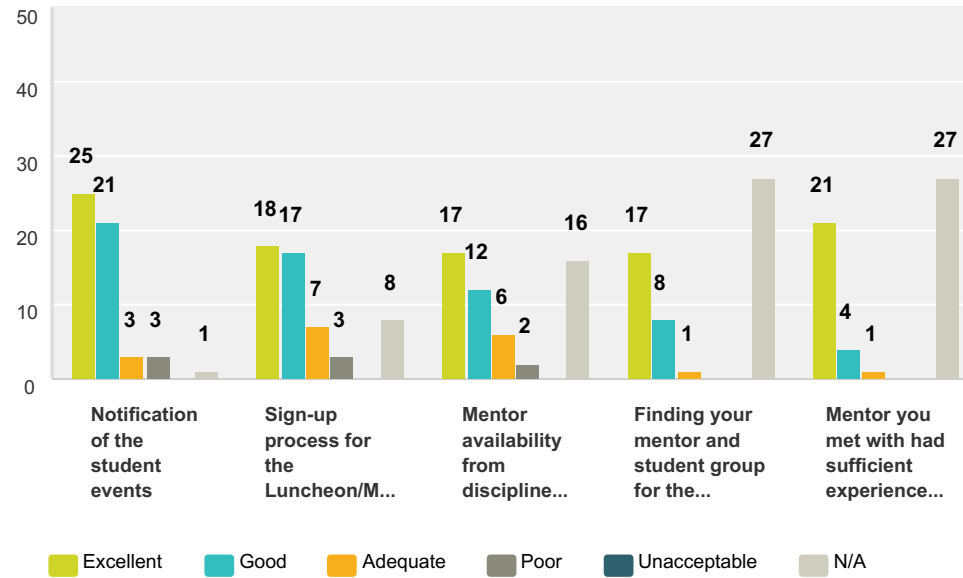

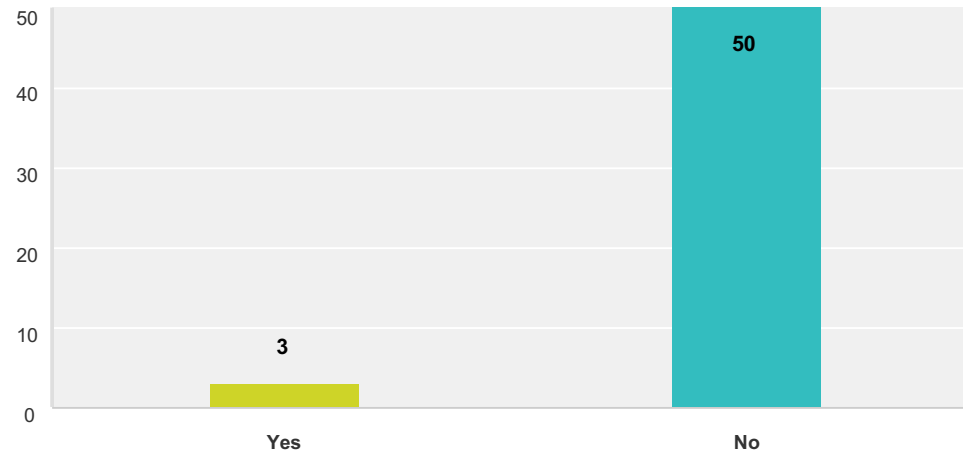

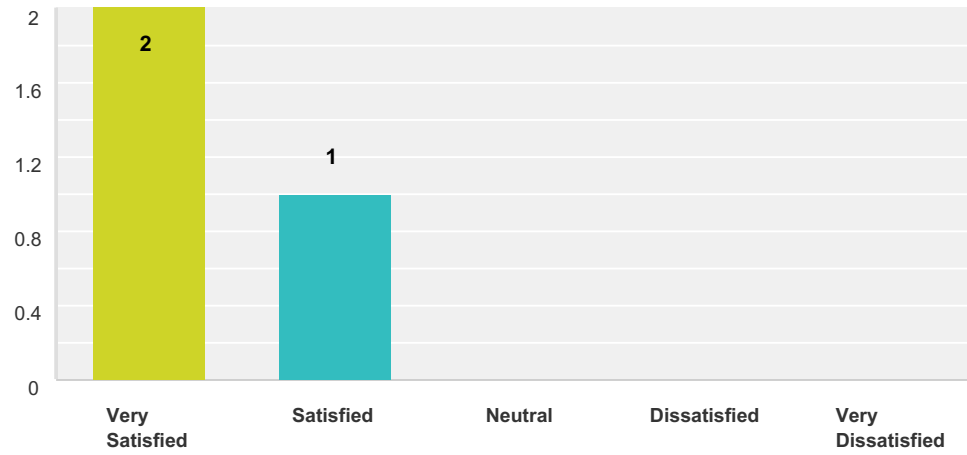

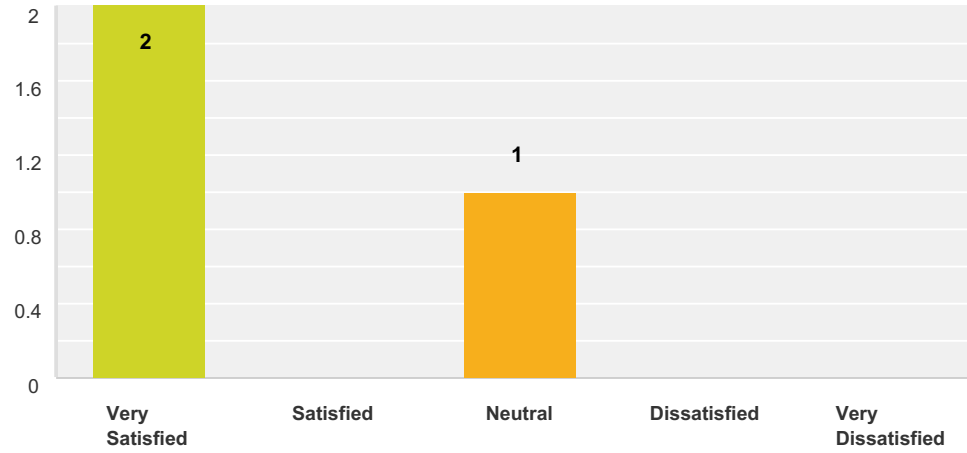

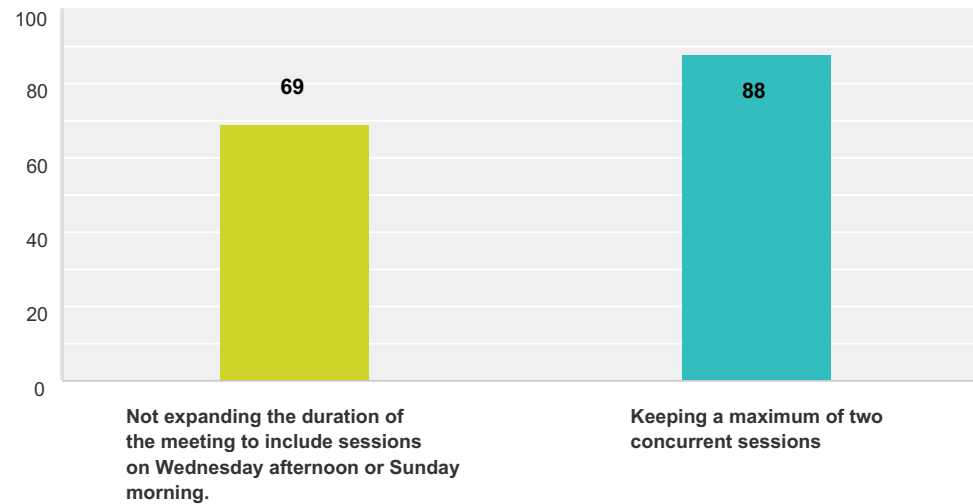
**Q22 Would you be interested in attending events similar to the Women in Science Breakfast if they addressed issues related to inclusivity and diversity in science?**

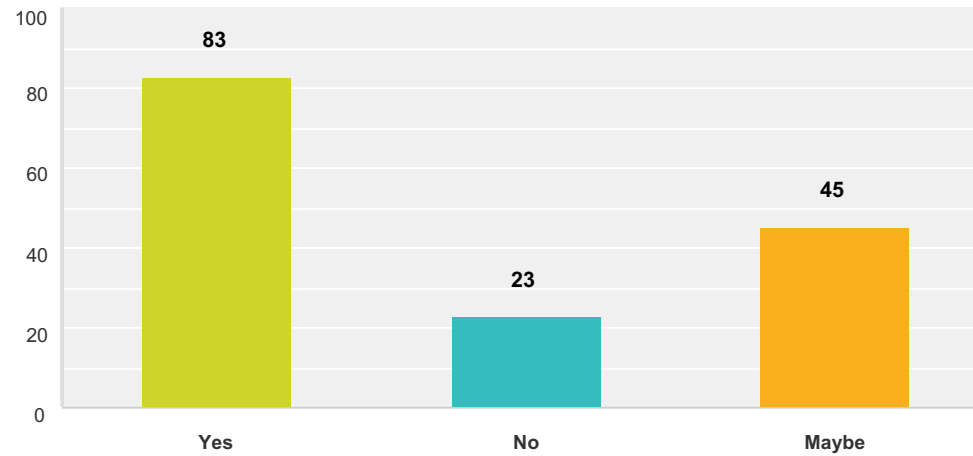

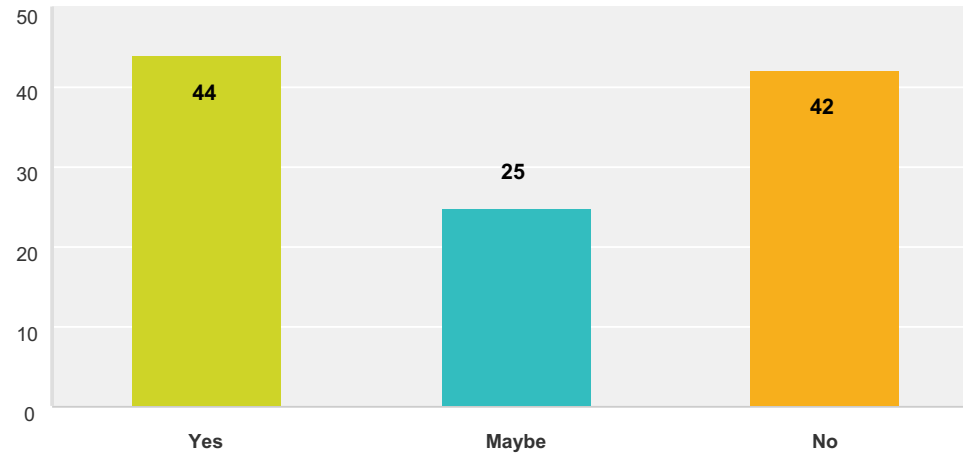

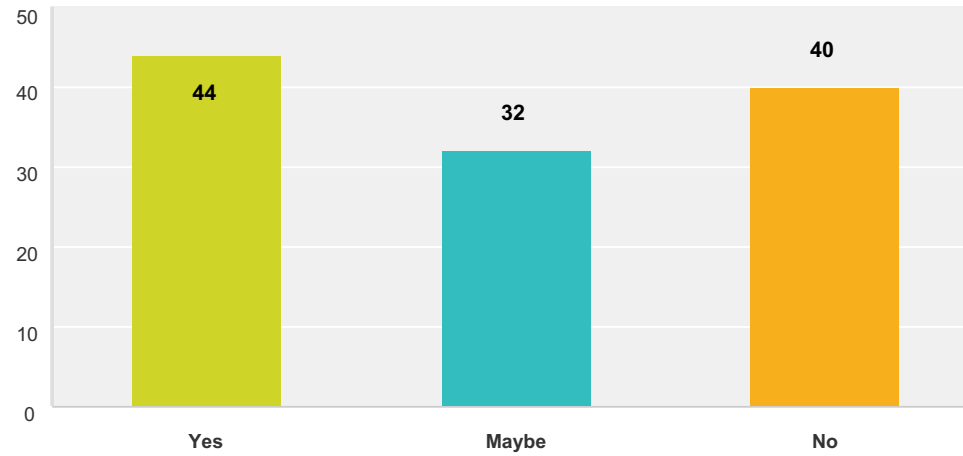
